Application to attend Off Campus Instruction

A limited number (up to 25) of Deshler Juniors and Seniors may attend the Muscle Shoals Career Academy to enroll in courses offered for auto body, welding, carpentry, or cosmetology or Northwest Shoals Community College for selected career, technical and occupational programs. Any transportation, supplies, and fees will be the responsibility of the students and parents/guardians.

In order to be considered for these courses, each student must complete the application process to include:

- An application to attend MSCA or NWSCC
- The Kuder self-assessments to support their course selection
- Meeting with the counselor, principal, and/or Career Tech Director to discuss the self-assessment results and application.

The student's academic, attendance, and discipline information will be reviewed as part of the application process. In addition, if a student is selected and does not complete the program or is removed from the program due to discipline and/or attendance issues, the student and parents may be responsible for reimbursing Tuscumbia City Schools for the costs associated with enrolling the student in the program (\$500 per semester for MSCA).

Students seeking a modified school day must meet at least one of the following requirements. Students must be in good academic standing and on track to graduate with their cohort and have parents/guardians permission along with the permission of the administration.

1. Be enrolled in an approved Technical Education Training Program.
2. Enrollment in an approved Dual Enrollment during the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and taken on the campus of college providing the course or taken on the campus of Deshler High School.
3. Enrolled in the Deshler High School.

a. Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- i. Be a senior in good academic standing, on track to graduate, must be at least 17 years of age, and credentialled in at least one area. Be a junior in good standing enrolled in Co-op or a college course.
- ii. Gainfully employed, seeking employment, or enrolled in dual enrollment.
- iii. Enrolled in at least 2 courses on the campus of Deshler High School.
- iv. Approved by the senior counselor along with transcript and records checks.
- v. Students must sign out daily through the Attendance Office on the campus of Deshler High School with the exception of Co-op.

- b. Failure to maintain good academic standing will result in the student forfeiting the right to be involved in the modified school day.
- c. Failure to maintain good behavior during school will result in the student forfeiting the right to be involved in the modified school day.
- d. It is the students and parents/guardians responsibility to retrieve all information distributed during the day in regards to senior activities other than the normal promulgation of announcements.
- e. Students may be allowed to participate in extra-curricular activities as a normal student would be allowed provided they maintain good academic and behavior standing with the school.
- f. Final approval or rejection rests with the administration of Deshler High School.
